

Sled Rules:

- Sleds must consist of cardboard, glue and tape only. Materials like paint may be used to help decorate the structure but the structural integrity of the sled must be cardboard. That means no hardware or other materials permitted (NO wood, plastic, metal, rope, string, foam)
- Base of the sled can only be cardboard or tape
- Any tape can be used
- Decorating your sled with paint, pictures, flags, etc. is encouraged.
- Sleds must be functional as a sled – ie: a person must ride the sled down the hill in order to participate. There is no limit to the number of people that can ride in the sled
- For the safety of our riders, sleds may not be attached to one another. You can, however, build a sled large enough to fit more than one person!
- All riders that leave the starting line must cross the finish line with the sled
- Sleds must be free of sharp or pointy objects.
- All parts, pieces and accessories must be taken with you when you leave Carry In, Carry Out
- NO open flames

Rules for Participants

- Anyone can participate – there is no age limit!
- Costumes are encouraged

Prizes will be given for the following:

- Most Creative Sled – People choice
- First sled across the finish line – group start, first sled to cross the line wins
- Last Sled Standing – the sled that takes the most successful runs and remains intact

Tailgate to follow: bring your grills, food and beverages (ensure adult beverages are discreet!)
